

P.1 Spellings and Dictation Lesson Notes Term I

1. <u>Look- say- Write – read – check.</u>

This is said to be the principal method of teaching the spelling especially of tricky or irregular words. Note the procedure.

- > Have the words written on the flash cards or chalkboard.
- ➤ Let the children look at one word at a time and read them aloud as whole class, small groups and individually.
- > Cover the word after children have had practice with them.
- ➤ Let the children copy the words in their exercise books, or the teacher can also dictate them as children write them.
- > Uncover the words and let children check by way of marking themselves.
- > Give the scores and appraise.
- 2. Skill practice is essential to enable children explore skills that improve their spellings. The following are some of them.
- a. Jumbling letters for children to write the words correctly.
- b. Joining word parts to make whole words.
- c. Giving dictation exercise.
- d. Using the given word to make sentences.
- e. Filling the gaps to complete words.
- f. Filling the gaps in the story to make it sensible.
