- i) It leads to success.
- ii) It leads to peace and harmony.
- iii) It helps to create more friends.

### RESULTS / OUTCOMES OF MAKING BAD DECISIONS

i) It makes God Unhappy.

- ii) It annoys other people or creates hatred among people.iii) It bring conflicts among people
- iv) It puts us into shame

# **EXAMPLES OF GOOD DECISION MAKERS IN THE BIBLE (Prov. 27:12)**

He accepted to sacrifice his only son

# **LESSONS (5&6)**

# **Bad decision makers in the bible (Luke 1:26-39)** "Read the bible for the children".

#### (i) Judas Iscariot

He accepted to betray Jesus

He stole money from apostle's bag.

He hanged himself.

### (ii) King Herod the Great

He ordered for the killing of baby boys who were 2 years and below in order to kill baby Jesus.

## (iii) Simon Peter

He denied Jesus Christ.

### (iv) Pontius Pilate

He sentenced Jesus to death

## (v) Adam and Eve

The disobeyed God by eating the forbidden fruit

## (vi) Cain

He killed his brother Abel due to jealousy.

#### (vii) Jonah

He disobeyed God by refusing to go and preach to the people of Nineveh instead he went to Spain.

# (viii) King Darius

He ordered his officers to throw Daniel into the den of lions.

# **LESSONS (7&8)**

# HOW TO MAKE GOOD DECISIONS (Gen. 22:1-19 & Luke 22:54-62)

- (i) Never be quick to make decisions.
- (ii) Avoid making decisions when you are angry.
- (iii) Do not be biased in the decision you make
- (iv) Consider the effect/ outcome of the decision you make.
- (v) Request God to help you in making a good decision.
- (vi) Never take decision in fear.
- (vii) Allow other people to advise you but not to decide for you.

### MAKING UNSELFISH DECISIONS AND KEEPING THEM WITH GOD'S HELP.

### a) What causes selfishness?

- Greed
- Ignorance
- Poor vision ahead

**NB:** A greedy person makes decisions that only favor oneself.

# b) Examples of unselfish decisions in societies

- Getting married in church
- Accepting Jesus as your personal savior
- Saying no to drugs
- Doing voluntary work in the community
- Having time to play.
- Having time to pray oneself and others.

### c) Examples of selfish decisions

- Telling lies
- Stealing other people's things.
- Men marrying more the one wife.
- Fighting for earthly materials.

- Depending on drugs.
- Being addicted to work and not having time to rest
- Using public funds to satisfy oneself (Corruption).

# d) Examples of people in the Bible that made selfish decisions

- i) King David (2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 11:1-26)
- ii) King Solomon
- iii) Prophet Jonah
- iv) King Herod
- v) King Ahab (1<sup>st</sup> kings 21 :1-28)
- vi) Ananias and Saphira (Acts 5: 1-11)

## e) Mention how Jesus' decisions were unselfish

- i) He accepted to die on the cross for our sins.
- ii) He ate with the rejects in public.
- iii) He refused the temptations of the devil.
- iv) He defended the sinners.
- v) He prayed for the people.
- vi) He feed the hungry.

# f) Ways of keeping good decisions with the help of God

- By the help of the Holy Spirit we can make good decisions.
- -Always pray for God's guidance before we can make unselfish decisions.

NB: When we make good decisions, they are blessed by God. However don't be discouraged if your right decisions are resisted by the people around you.

- (ii) Asking for forgiveness.
- (iii) Hand shaking and hugging
- (iv) Sharing a meal or drinks.

# **RELIGIOUS WAYS OF RESTORING PEACE**

- i) Praying for the offender.
- ii) Asking for forgiveness /repenting.
- iii) Through guidance and counseling.
- iv) By organizing peace talks among the conflicting parties.
- v) Through sharing Jesus' body and blood.

# **BIBLICAL WAYS OF RESTORING PEACE**

- i) Through sending greetings (1Samuel 25; 1-36)
- ii) Through asking for forgiveness (Genesis 45:1-28, Luke 14:11-32)

- Listening to each other
- Asking for forgiveness
- Respecting each other

## PROBLEMS THAT DISRUPT PEACE

-Unforgiveness -Injustice -poverty

-Hatred -Tribalism -drug addiction

-Greed -Malice -Wars -Famine

#### **EFFECTS OF WARS**

- Death of people
- Hatred
- Suffering
- Destruction of property

#### **LESSON 13 & 14**

### HOW WAS THE PEACE OF ISRAELITES DISTURBED IN EGYPT?

- -They were forced to do hard work without payment.
- -They were killed without cause.
- -The newly born males were killed.
- They were mistreated and tortured.

#### **GOD'S PROMISE FOR PEACE**

- -God promised peace through the messiah
- -God's son would be called Emmanuel and Prince of Peace
- -God's promise for peace was achieved through Jesus' birth, suffering and death.

# WAYS OF MAKING PEACE IN THE BIBLE (Lev. 26:3-13)

- (i) Obeying God's commandments.
- (ii) Being helpful to others
- (iii) Loving one another
- (iv) Not taking revenge
- (v) Forgiving your enemies
- (vi) Sharing what you have with other people
- (vii) Being tolerant to one another.

# SUGGESTIONS JESUS MADE TOWARDS PEACE MAKING

- -Do not revenge on someone who wrongs you. (Matthew 18:21-35)
- -Lend things to other people
- -Love your enemies and pray for them.

#### **LESSONS 15 & 16**

#### **RECONCILIATION (Romans 5:1)**

- -It is making friendship after a disagreement with someone.
- -It means restoring friendship after disagreeing with someone.

# **IMPORTANCE OF RECONCILIATION**

- iv) It restores working relationship.

# TRADITIONAL WAYS OF RECONCILIATION
