- ✓ God first appeared to Moses in form of a burning bush.
- ✓ This was at the foot of Mt Sinai (Horeb).
- ✓ God told Moses to remove his sandals because he was standing on a holy ground.
- ✓ God told Moses that his name was 'I am who I am'
- ✓ He sent Moses to rescue the Israelites from Egyptian slavery.
- ✓ His brother Aaron was made to be Moses' spokesman.

Why did Moses refuse God's call at first?

- He was a poor speaker.
- He had killed an Egyptian.
- It was his first time to talk to God.

Signs God gave to Moses.

- To throw down his stick and it would turn into a snake.
- To turn the water into blood.
- To put his arm into his chest and it would turn leprosy.
