They were worshipping idols, committing adultery, stealing God's things from temples and killing God's prophets. God was angry with all men except Noah and his family. He alone behaved in the way God wanted.

Because of their many sins and unrepentant attitude, God decided to destroy all the people of Israel and spare only Noah's family and a pair of each species of plants and animals in that land. He ordered Noah to construct an ark in which he would take refuge with his family and the selected plants and animals. God instructed him to complete the work in sixty days.

Although the work was hard and tedious, Noah trusted God and obeyed all his instructions. Together with his sons: Shem, Ham and Japhet, they built the ark day and night for sixty days until it was completed as the last day struck midnight.

Then, God gave Noah ninety days to collect food, the animals and plants and enter the ark at midnight of the last day. He was told to close the door of the ark and pray to God until morning.

God sent floods that destroyed all people, animals and plants that were not in Noah's ark. Floodwaters covered all treetops, mountain peaks and roofs of buildings and killed the people who had escaped to higher points to survive the floods. Noah, his family, the selected animals and plants survived because the ark was able to float of the floodwaters. **Questions**
