Kaliro left school when he was in Primary Four. This <u>happened</u> when he fought his teacher, Mr. Kintu, after being asked to pick litter in the school compound because he had not done his home homework.

It followed an incident when Kaliro was caught stealing Bunjo's money. Bunjo was his classmate. The headmaster of the school called for an urgent assembly in front of all the pupils. He was accused of bad **behaviour** and indiscipline. Most pupils in Primary Four testified that Kaliro was not only bad in school but also on the way home. He used to fight pupils of Nyenga Primary School, their neighbouring school. He would also steal sugarcane from Mr. Kigoma's garden.

When the headmaster heard all this, he told Kaliro to bring his parent to school. Kaliro didn't go home that evening. He instead went to the town streets and started street life.

He started pick-pocketing and snatching ladies' bags for survival. The police carried out a hunt one day and Kaliro was arrested. He is now serving a sentence at Mpigi Remand Home.
