MICROSOFT WORD

Microsoft Word is a menu driven application package. Most of its text manipulations involve using the Menu and Toolbars/ribbons (with the help of the mouse buttons) or even the keyboard.

Word

Toolbars/ribbons have a brief description of what each one does and also a symbolic representation of its effect in the document, so one can quickly move a mouse pointer and read what it does.

As shortcuts, when text is highlighted (left button), the right button has some few of the operations that can be carried out on the text e.g. copy, cut etc.

Help (F1 key) allows a user to get guidance on how a particular text manipulation is carried out.

NOTE: After using, its window should be closed.
