2. "There is no difference between the Abrahamic Covenant and Sinaic Covenant"
Discuss. (25 marks)
3. (a). Discuss the significance of the food regulations that were given to the Israelites in Leviticus. (13 marks)
(b). What is the New Testament interpretation of these food laws or prohibitions? (12 marks)
4. (a). Analyze the theme of love as taught by Moses in Deuteronomy 6. (13 marks)
(b). Why did the Israelites abuse the privileges of being God's people on reaching the Promised Land? (12 marks)

SECTION B **HISTORICAL BOOKS**

5. (a). Explain the fears Samuel had concerning Monarchism in Israel. (13 marks)
(b). Examine the short comings of King David (12 marks)
6. (a). Justify the view that King Ahab was the most notorious King of Israel. (13 marks)
(b). What lessons do political leaders learn from Ahab's reign? (12 marks)
7. (a). Discuss the circumstances under which Jehu came to be elected King of Israel. (13 marks)
(b). Explain the relevance of Jehu's rule to the political leaders today. (12 marks)

SECTION C

Answer two questions from this section, one of which should be question 12.

8. Compare the vocations of the time prophets of Israel with those of the Pseudo (professional) prophets. (25 marks)
9. (a) Discuss the meaning of the five visions that Amos received during his call. (13 marks)
(b). Explain the relevance of the above signs to Christians in Uganda today. (12 marks)
10. (a). According to Deutero – Isaiah, discuss the characteristics of the suffering servant of Yahweh. (13 marks)
(b). In what ways do Christians today suffer for the sake of the gospel? (12 marks)
11. (a). Examine Ezekiel’s prophecy concerning the shepherds of Israel. (13 marks)
(b). How do these shepherds differ from Jesus, the good shepherd? (12 marks)
12. “Even my friends laugh at me now, they laugh, although I am righteous and blameless” (Job 12:4)
(a). Why did Job utter this statement? (13 marks)
(b). What lessons do Christians learn about suffering from Job’s experience? (12 marks)
