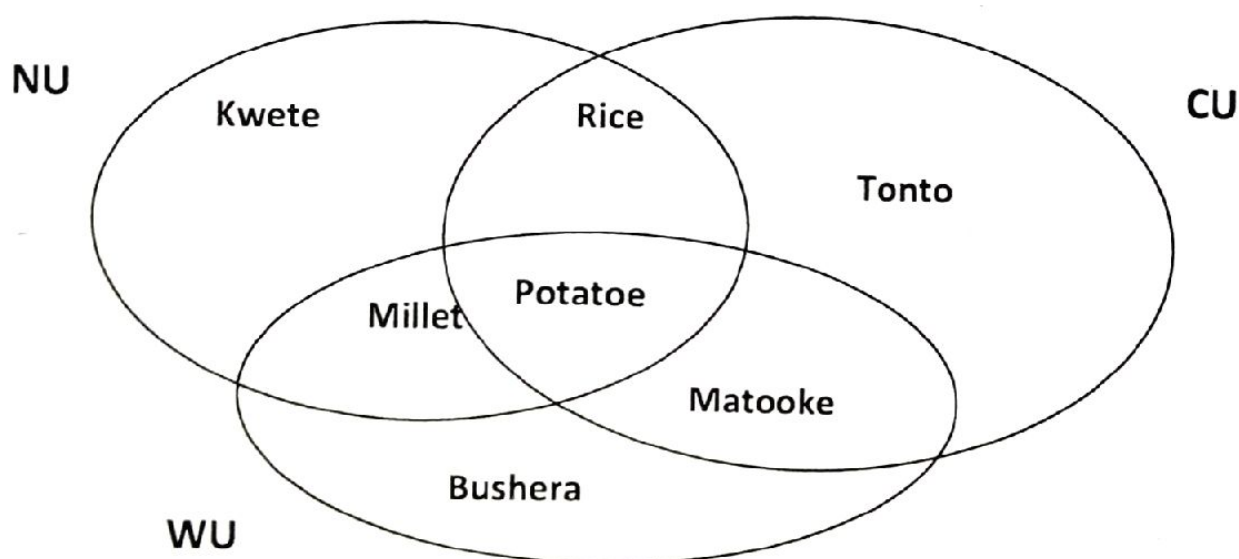

QUESTION 1

The table below shows the number of customers who like different types of food and drinks based on culture. Use it to answer the following questions:

- a. Editing the shape of the sets. (01 mark)
- b. Including the elements of each set in the venn diagram. (02 marks)
- c. Grouping all objects and the sets to form one venn diagram. (02 marks)
- d. Copying and pasting the venn diagram on page 2. (02 marks)
- e. Adjusting the set to appear at the bottom of page 2. (02 marks)
- C) Save the file as *culture*. (01 mark)
- D) Print your work on two pages. (01 mark)

QUESTION 2

Paul is a business man who buys domestic animals and birds from villages at lower prices. He then sells them in the city for profits.

- a) Load the file *animal-bird.xls* using Spreadsheet application of your choice. (01 mark)
- b) Indicate **Each Cost**, **Total Cost**, **Each Sale**, **Total Sales**, **Profit**, **Tax** and **Net Profit** on cells **C1**, **D1**, **E1**, **F1**, **G1**, **H1** and **I1** respectively. (02 marks)
- c) Insert a row before row 1 and the Title: "Business as at end of May 2019", bold, Merge and center the title. (02 marks)
- d) Enter the following amount in shillings under the Each Sale column as: Cow: 880,000, Goat: 330,000, Pig: 550,000, Sheep: 275,000, Dog: 770,000, Cat: 55,000, Bull: 990,000, Chicken: 33,000, Dove: 55,000 and Horse: 5,500,000 (02 marks)
- e) Use formula to calculate the
 - i. Total Cost and Total Sale of Paul's animal/bird in May 2019. (02 marks)
 - ii. Profits made when these animals/birds are sold. (02 marks)
- f) Use function to compute Tax. Note that profits are Taxed as follow:
 - i. Profit of less than or equal to 250,000 is not taxed.
 - ii. Profit of less than or equal to 500,000 is 2% taxed.

iii. Profit of less than or equal to 250,000 is 4% taxed.

iv. Otherwise its 8% taxed.

g) Draw a column chart to represent the Net Profits made in selling Animal/birds in the month of May 2019. Name the Title, Axes and Legend clearly on the chart (03 marks)

h) Include your name and number on the footer of your chart. (01 mark)

i) Save the file as *may2019* and print your work. (01 mark)

j) Print the grids and chart on separate papers. (02 marks)

- b) Produce the Order table with correct primary key and appropriate data types for the given fields. (04 marks)
- c) Use the order form to enter all the records. (04 marks)
- d) Use the design view of the form to automatically compute the total cost for items ordered. Save it as *total cost*. (03 marks)
- e) Design a query having item name, quantity, and cost per item, total cost and No. of days that can produce number of elapse day from the date of order. Save the query as *elapse days*. (03 marks)
- f) Produce the report of **elapse days** query with all it fields. Save the report as *elapse days*. (03 marks)
- g) Save changes and print the report created in landscape format. (02 marks)

QUESTION 4

In this era of dot com, primary schools, colleges and secondary schools children are suppose to be smart and healthy at schools. Assume you are appointed Health prefect of your school and you are required to make awareness about Personal Hygiene at School;

- a) Use suitable presentation software to design a five-slide presentation about Personal Hygiene at schools. Include the following information:

iv. **Slide 4:** Using pyramid Art object, List any three measures to be enforced by schools' and students' administrations to restore hygiene in Secondary Schools in Uganda today. (02 marks)

v. **Slide 5:** Make a summary of the topic. (02 marks)

b) Insert relevant graphics in your presentation from support file. (01 mark)

c) Apply suitable animation and slide transition to your presentation. (02 marks)

d) In footer, insert your name and current date. (02 marks)

e) Make the slides to be seen continuously moving after 20 seconds until you press Esc key on the keyboard. (02 marks)

Assume you are to design an identity card similar to one in Fig.1 to be used at Universities and colleges. Use it to answer the following questions:

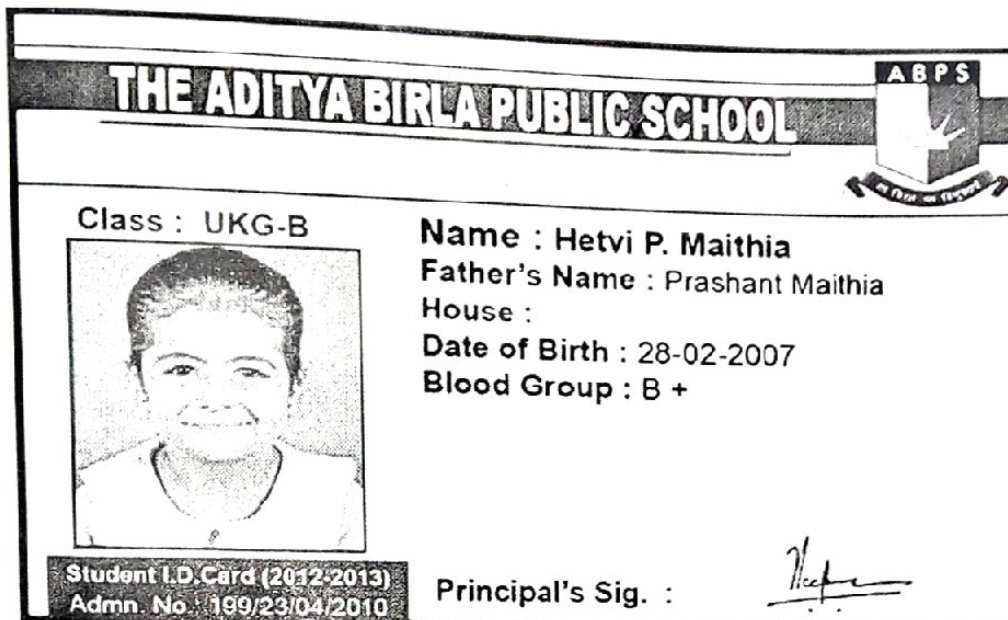
