"Apple Inc. plans to use a larger screen on the next-generation iPhone and has to place orders for the new displays from suppliers in South Korea and Japan familiar with the situation said on Wednesday.

"The new iPhone screens will measure 4 inches from corner to corner", one source.

That would represent a roughly 30 percent increase in viewing area, assuming keeps other dimensions proportional. Apple has used a 3.5 inch screen introducing the iPhone in 2007.

That would allow the new IPhone to go into production as soon as August, 2019 if the company follows its own precedent in moving from orders for prototypes for key components to launching original and genuine products. Apple's decision to equip the next iPhone with a larger screen represents part a competitive response to Samsung Electronics Co. Ltd. Samsung unveiled its top-of-the line Galaxy smartphone with a 4.8 inch touch-screen and a faster processor earlier mis month.
